

Presidential Fact Finders

George Washington and Abraham Lincoln were two of our most celebrated United States presidents. Play this Presidential Fact Finders Game to learn more about these two men.

Copy this fact sheet and the president silhouettes on to colored paper, a different color for each child who is playing. Cut out the fact cards and hide them. Assign each player a color and have them hunt for their clues, then glue them on to the president that matches each statement. The first one done that gets them all correct is the winner. (Answers: The top row is Lincoln; the bottom row is Washington.)
